- Be able to communicate with parents, colleagues, and students clearly and accurately, both orally and in writing
- Have a strong sense of self, a good sense of humor, and a positive outlook on one's professional endeavors
- Familiarity and comfort with digital platforms like Zoom, Seesaw and Google Classroom

Duties and Expectations

- Report to the Early Childhood and Lower School Division Director
- Under the direction of the Lead Teacher, deliver instruction and support to students throughout their day
- Promote student involvement and participation in all aspects of the program
- Help to set and monitor the tone of the classroom to ensure an environment which is well-ordered and exhibits respect for classmates, teachers, and the school as a whole
- If necessary, teach remotely using Zoom, google classroom, Seesaw or other digital learning platforms
- Supervise lunch, recess and help set up learning activities.
- Serve as a substitute teacher when the classroom teacher is not available
